

SAFETY MEASURES FOR COMMUNITY COMPETITION TENNIS

Your Mid-Week Men's Sub-Committee accepts that our competition is bound by specific rules relating to the control of community transmission of Covid-19, laid down by the Victorian Government, adopted by Tennis Victoria and Waverley Tennis Committee of Management for Community Tennis Competition. The rules for Community Tennis Competitions differ from those applicable to Tournament type events which are judged to have increased risks.

A brief summary of rules applicable to our MWM competition involving unstaffed clubhouses and outdoor courts, follows -

1. Such venues can open for everyone including spectators.
2. Vaccination status is not required to be confirmed.
3. Vaccination is encouraged but is not compulsory.
4. Venues should ensure that there is appropriate signage and provision for all patrons to Check-in preferably using QR Codes.
5. Toilets can be open for everyone.
6. Masks must be worn when not competing.
7. All venues/clubs should maintain an up to date and visibly displayed COVIDSafe plan.
8. Players and spectators are encouraged to practice the COVIDSafe principles.
9. At their discretion, some clubs may wish to introduce measures beyond the above guidelines. Tennis Victoria recognises and supports the ability of clubs to do so.
10. Unvaccinated players & spectators are not permitted to enter clubhouses except to go to toilet.
11. Clubs should make available hand sanitizer, promote social distancing, touching of rackets and wearing of masks, not supply food, etc.
